




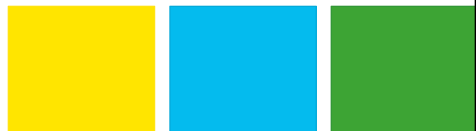

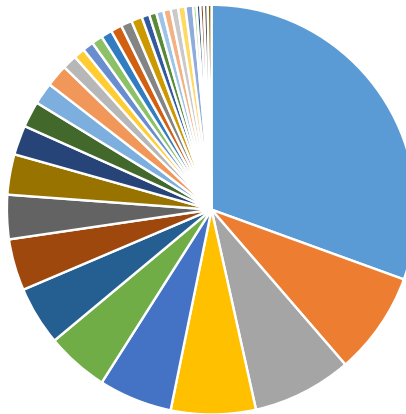

<p>Ensure strict performance in areas of:</p> <p>Oversight / supervision</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have a Cefic / Sector Group - Affiliated Group Secretariat representative at each meeting; Consult with appropriate counsel on all questions which might be related to competition law; Limit meeting discussions to agenda topics; Provide each attendee with a copy of this checklist, and have a copy available for reference at all meetings. <p>Responsible</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have an agenda and minutes which accurately reflect the matters which occur; Ensure the review of agendas, minutes and other important documents be appropriate (and/or counsel, in advance of distribution); Fully describe the purpose, structure and attributes of the group. <p>Vigilance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prevent any discussion or meeting activities which appear to violate this checklist, and for those activities to be stopped so that appropriate legal (if/it) can be made by counsel; if/it/initials provided from any such discussion or activities and for the attendant, leave any meeting to which they continue (and have it recorded). <p>This checklist is for the conduct of Cefic-sponsored meetings. Prohibited discussion topics apply equally to social gatherings incidental to those meetings. The checklist is not exhaustive.</p>	<p>Do not, in fact or appearance, discuss or exchange information not in conformity with competition law, including for example on:</p> <p>Prices, including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Individual company / industry prices, price changes, price differentials, discounts, allowances, credit terms, etc.; Individual company data on sales, production, capacity (other than nameplate capacities), investments, sales, etc. <p>Production, including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plans of individual companies concerning the design, production, distribution or marketing of particular products, including proposed territories or customers; Changes in industry production capacity (other than nameplate capacities) or investments, etc. <p>Transportation rates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rates or rate policies for individual enterprises, including leasing point systems, zone prices, freight, etc. <p>Market provisions, including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Company bids on contracts for particular products, company procedures for responding to bid invitations; ... Matters relating to actual or potential individual suppliers or customers that might have the effect of excluding them from any market or influencing the business contacts of firms toward them, etc.; Blacklist or boycott customers or suppliers.
